19 Plaintiff and Petitioner SAN DIEGANS FOR OPEN GOVERNMENT ("SDOG") alleges as
20 follows:

21 **Introductory Statement**

22 1. SDOG brings this lawsuit under the California Public Records Act ("CPRA"), as well
23 as the California Constitution, the common law, and other applicable legal authorities. Defendants,
24 Respondents, and Real Parties in Interest knowingly and intentionally used personal e-mail accounts
25 and text-messaging devices (e.g., mobile phones and tablets) to communicate about illegal political
26 activity they were conducting – without being subject to public scrutiny – on Measure BB appearing
27 on the November 2016 ballot. Despite the efforts at secrecy, those communications constitute public
28 records. SDOG requested those public records but was not provided with all responsive public records.

1 **Parties**

2 2. SDOG is a non-profit organization formed and operating under the laws of the State of
3 California. One of its primary roles as a government “watchdog” is ensuring that public agencies
4 comply with all applicable laws aimed at promoting transparency and accountability in government.

5 3. Defendant and Respondent Defendant and Respondent GROSSMONT UNION HIGH
6 SCHOOL DISTRICT (“GUHSD”) is a “local agency” under Section 6252(a) of the CPRA.

7 4. Defendant and Real Party in Interest TIM GLOVER (“GLOVER”) is the GUHSD’s
8 superintendent of schools and was the primary (but perhaps not the only) GUHSD employee using
9 private communications devices to conduct illegal public business on the ballot measure in secret.

10 5. The true names and capacities of the Defendants/Respondents identified as DOES 1
11 through 100 and Defendants/Real Parties in Interest 101 through 1,000 are unknown to SDOG, who will
12 seek the Court’s permission to amend this pleading in order to allege the true names and capacities as
13 soon as they are ascertained. SDOG is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that each of the
14 fictitiously named Defendants/Respondents 1 through 100 has jurisdiction by law over one or more
15 aspects of the public records that are the subject of this lawsuit or has some other cognizable interest
16 in the public records, and that each of the fictitiously named Defendants/Real Parties in Interest 101
17 through 1,000 has some cognizable interest in the public records.

18 6. SDOG is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that, at all times stated in this
19 pleading, each Defendant/Respondent/Real Party in Interest was the agent, servant, or employee of
20 every other Defendant/Respondent/Real Party in Interest and was, in doing the things alleged in this
21 pleading, acting within the scope of said agency, servitude, or employment and with the full knowledge
22 or subsequent ratification of his principals, masters, and employers. Alternatively, in doing the things
23 alleged in this pleading, each Defendant/Respondent was acting alone and solely to further his own
24 interests.

25 **Jurisdiction and Venue**

26 7. The Court has jurisdiction over this lawsuit pursuant to Government Code Sections 6258
27 and 6259; Code of Civil Procedure Sections 526a, 1060 *et seq.*, and 1084 *et seq.*; the California
28 Constitution, and the common law, among other provisions of law.

1 to believe that such public records exist.” A true and correct copy of the e-mail is attached to this
2 pleading as Exhibit “E.”

3 15. On or about November 18, 2016, GUHSD sent SDOG what GUHSD described as its
4 “final response to your request for records.” A true and correct copy of the final response is attached
5 to this pleading as Exhibit “F.”

6 16. SDOG is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that responsive public records
7 exist for categories 2b, 3a, 3b, 4a, 4b, and/or 6 in the SDOG Request but those responsive public
8 records have not been provided to SDOG.

9 17. SDOG is further informed and believes and on that basis further alleges:

10 A. By way of example and not limitation, in October 2016 GLOVER made the
11 following statements, among others, to subordinate GUHSD employees in a communication falling
12 under the “mobile messages” definition in the SDOG Request:

13 1. “I want to give you a quick update about Friday nights [*sic*] BB Pollster
14 information. . . .”

15 2. “Ps [*sic*] best to respond to my home email Theglov8@gmail.com.”

16 B. With regard to category 2b in the SDOG Request:

17 1. GLOVER did not perform any search for responsive public records
18 beyond those found on GUHSD’s server.

19 2. Additionally and alternatively, GLOVER did not perform a thorough
20 search for responsive public records beyond those found on GUHSD’s server.

21 3. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed any search for
22 responsive public records beyond those found on GUHSD’s server.

23 4. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed a thorough search for
24 responsive public records beyond those found on GUHSD’s server.

25 C. With regard to category 3a in the SDOG Request:

26 1. GLOVER did not perform any search for responsive public records.

27 2. Additionally and alternatively, GLOVER did not perform a thorough
28 search for responsive public records.

1 3. Additionally and alternatively, GLOVER limited his search for responsive
2 public records to cell phones owned or controlled by GUHSD that he knew did not exist even though
3 the request was not limited to cell phones.

4 4. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed any search for
5 responsive public records.

6 5. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed a thorough for
7 responsive public records.

8 6. Additionally and alternatively, all persons other than GLOVER who
9 performed a search for responsive public records limited their search to cell phones owned or controlled
10 by GUHSD that they knew did not exist even though the request was not limited to cell phones.

11 D. With regard to category 3b in the SDOG Request:

12 1. GLOVER did not perform any search for responsive public records.

13 2. Additionally and alternatively, GLOVER did not perform a thorough
14 search for responsive public records.

15 3. Additionally and alternatively, GLOVER limited his search for responsive
16 public records to cell phones owned or controlled by GUHSD that he knew did not exist even though
17 the request was not limited to cell phones.

18 4. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed any search for
19 responsive public records.

20 5. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed a thorough for
21 responsive public records.

22 6. Additionally and alternatively, all persons other than GLOVER who
23 performed a search for responsive public records limited their search to cell phones owned or controlled
24 by GUHSD that they knew did not exist even though the request was not limited to cell phones.

25 E. With regard to category 4a in the SDOG Request:

26 1. GLOVER did not perform any search for responsive public records.

27 2. Additionally and alternatively, GLOVER did not perform a thorough
28 search for responsive public records.

1 3. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed any search for
2 responsive public records.

3 4. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed a thorough for
4 responsive public records.

5 F. With regard to category 4b in the SDOG Request:

6 1. GLOVER did not perform any search for responsive public records.

7 2. Additionally and alternatively, GLOVER did not perform a thorough
8 search for responsive public records.

9 3. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed any search for
10 responsive public records.

11 4. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed a thorough for
12 responsive public records.

13 G. With regard to category 6 in the SDOG Request:

14 1. GLOVER did not perform any search for responsive public records.

15 2. Additionally and alternatively, GLOVER did not perform a thorough
16 search for responsive public records.

17 3. Additionally and alternatively, GLOVER limited his search for responsive
18 public records to cell phones owned or controlled by GUHSD that he knew did not exist even though
19 the request was not limited to cell phones.

20 4. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed any search for
21 responsive public records.

22 5. Additionally and alternatively, nobody performed a thorough for
23 responsive public records.

24 6. Additionally and alternatively, all persons other than GLOVER who
25 performed a search for responsive public records limited their search to cell phones owned or controlled
26 by GUHSD that they knew did not exist even though the request was not limited to cell phones.

27 H. Alternatively and additionally, Defendants/Respondents/Real Parties in Interest
28 did not seek clarification of the SDOG Request from SDOG despite needing such clarification.

1 18. SDOG and other members of the public have been harmed as a result of
2 Defendants'/Respondents' failure to produce the disclosable public records responsive to SDOG's
3 request. By way of example and not limitation, the state- and local-level constitutional rights of SDOG
4 and its members to access "information concerning the conduct of the people's business" is being
5 violated and continues to be violated.

6 **SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION:**
7 **Declaratory Relief under Code of Civil Procedure Section 1060 et seq.**
8 (Against All Defendants/Respondents/Real Parties in Interest)

9 19. Paragraphs 1 through 18 are fully incorporated into this paragraph.

10 20. SDOG is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that an actual controversy exists
11 between SDOG, on the one hand, and Defendants/Respondents/Real Parties in Interest, on the other
12 hand, concerning their respective rights and duties under the CPRA, the California Constitution, the
13 common law, and other applicable legal authorities. As alleged in this pleading, SDOG contends that
14 the records responsive to the SDOG Request are "public records" under the CPRA and that
15 Defendants/Respondents/Real Parties in Interest are required by law to produce them; whereas SDOG
16 is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that Defendants/Respondents/Real Parties in Interest
17 dispute SDOG's contention.

18 21. SDOG desires a judicial determination and declaration as to whether disclosable public
19 records were unlawfully withheld by Defendants/Respondents/Real Parties in Interest and whether they
20 were required by law to produce such records in a timely manner.

21 **Prayer**

22 FOR ALL THESE REASONS, SDOG respectfully prays for the following relief against all
23 Defendants/Respondents (and any and all other parties who may oppose SDOG in this lawsuit) jointly
24 and severally:

25 A. *On the First Cause of Action:*

26 1. A judgment determining or declaring that Defendants/Respondents have not
27 promptly and fully complied with the CPRA, the California Constitution, the common law, and/or other
28 applicable laws with regard to the SDOG Request;

1 2. A writ of mandate ordering Defendants/Respondents to promptly and fully
2 comply with the CPRA, the California Constitution, the common law, and all other applicable laws with
3 regard to the SDOG Request; and

4 3. Preliminary and permanent injunctive relief directing Defendants/Respondents
5 to fully respond to the SDOG Request and to permit SDOG to inspect and obtain copies of all
6 responsive public records.

7 B. *On the Second Cause of Action:*

8 1. An order determining and declaring that the failure of Defendants/Respondents
9 to disclose all public records responsive to the SDOG Request and to permit SDOG to inspect and
10 obtain copies of the responsive public records does not comply with the CPRA, the California
11 Constitution, the common law, and/or other applicable laws; and

12 2. Preliminary and permanent injunctive relief directing Defendants/Respondents
13 to disclose all public records responsive to the SDOG Request and to permit SDOG to inspect and
14 obtain copies of the responsive public records.

15 C. *On All Causes of Action:*

16 1. An order providing for the Court's continuing jurisdiction over this lawsuit in
17 order to ensure that Defendants/Respondents fully comply with the CPRA, the California Constitution,
18 the common law, and/or other applicable laws;

19 2. All attorney fees and other legal expenses incurred by SDOG in connection with
20 this lawsuit; and


21 3. Any further relief that this Court may deem appropriate.

Re: Request to Inspect and Obtain Copies of Public Records, Public Information, and Other Matters

Dear Superintendent Glover:

On behalf of Nick Marinovich and other clients and pursuant to the California Constitution (Article I, Section 3), the California Public Records Act (GOV'T CODE § 6250 *et seq.*), the common law, and your agency's own local rules and regulations, I am writing to request an opportunity to first inspect and then obtain copies of the "public records" (as that term, including public information and other matters, is defined under the foregoing authorities) listed on *Attachment 1: Categories of Requested Public Records* to this request.

To aid you in locating responsive records, I want to let you know why this request is being made (even though the law does not require that a reason be provided). It is believed that *you may have engaged in illegal, potentially criminal, political activity* as a public employee in relation to Measure BB on the November 2016 ballot. In particular, it is believed, among other things, that (i) during working hours you are pressuring parents, students, and/or your subordinate employees to campaign for Measure BB, including working the phone bank at Grossmont Center; (ii) that you are countenancing, if not requiring, subordinate employees' use of their official public-employee credentials while working the phone banks to lend support to Measure BB; (iii) that you are spending public money, or are seeking reimbursement from public resources, for food, supplies, and/or other tangible items provided to persons working the phone banks; and (iv) that you have directed subordinate employees during working hours to schedule personnel to fill phone-banking shifts when administrators are unable to do so. Accompanying this request is an article – "Election Fever! Regulating Political Activities of Public Employees" by attorney Julie H. Biggs – that will give you an idea of some of the illegal activity you may be committing.

I ask that you make a determination on this request within 10 days of your receiving it, or even sooner if you can do so without having to review the responsive records. If you believe that any of these records is exempt from disclosure, I urge you to note in your reply whether the exemption is discretionary and, if so, whether you are required to exercise your discretion to withhold the record in this particular case. If you determine that any portion of

the responsive records is exempt from disclosure and that you intend to withhold that portion, I ask that you redact that portion for the time being and make the other portion available as requested. In any event, please respond with a signed notification citing the legal authorities on which you rely if you determine that any portion of the responsive records, if not all of them, is exempt and will not be disclosed.

If public records responsive to this request are available in one or more non-paper formats (including but not limited to electronic, magnetic, or digital formats), make sure that your response to this request includes production of all responsive records in non-paper formats even if the records are also available in paper format. If there are no records responsive to a particular category listed on *Attachment 1*, please confirm in writing that such records do not exist; and if responsive records used to exist but have been lost, stolen, or destroyed, please (i) identify the date of loss, theft, or destruction and (ii) provide a copy of all available evidence of the loss, theft, or destruction.

All responsive records must be produced for inspection before my client will pay for copies, unless I agree otherwise in writing after receiving your estimate of copying costs. Furthermore, my client reserves the right to make its own reproduction of the responsive records, at its own expense.

Please keep in mind that Government Code Section 6200 provides, *inter alia* and with my emphasis, that every public officer having custody of any record "filed or deposited in any public office, or *placed in his or her hands for any purpose*, is punishable by imprisonment [for up to four years] . . . if, *as to the whole or any part of the record* . . . the officer willfully does or permits any other person to do any of the following: (a) Steal, remove, or secrete. (b) Destroy, mutilate, or deface. (c) Alter or falsify." Such mistreatment of public records constitutes a felony. I therefore urge you not to mistreat any of the public records covered by this request (or, for that matter, any others). (Because the same criminal sanctions could apply to any other public employee, I am cc-ing District administrators shown on the California Department of Education's website – <http://www.cde.ca.gov/re/sd/index.asp> – so that they are aware of the statute and can remind their faculty and staff not to destroy any potentially responsive public records.)

Thank you for your time and attention to this matter. If I can provide any clarification that will help you to expedite this request, please do not hesitate to contact me in writing. Because the law requires you to assist members of the public in making a focused and effective request that reasonably describes identifiable records, I will assume that you fully understand what public records are being sought unless I receive written correspondence from you to the contrary.

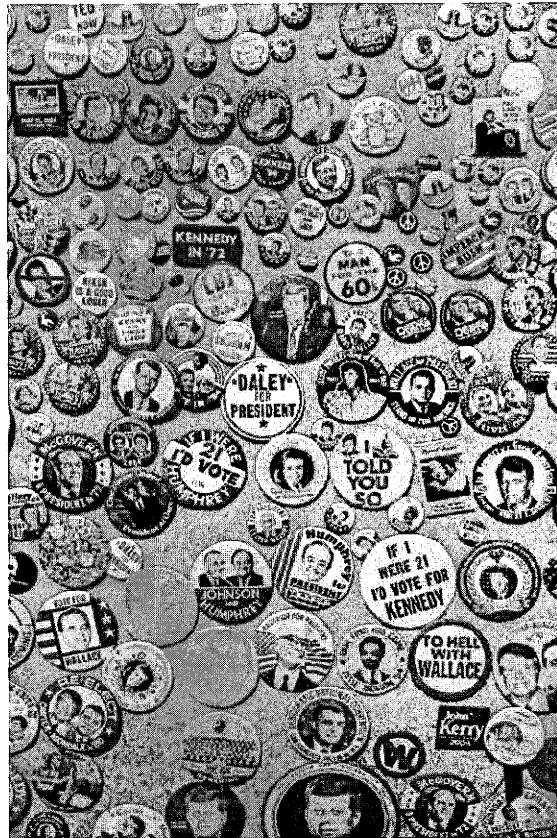

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Election Fever! Regulating Political Activities of Public Employees

By Julie H. Biggs, Esq.

Ever wonder what to do with those employees who insist on wearing "Vote For Sam" buttons during election season while on duty at your local public agency? Here is an analysis of California law relating to regulation of political activities of public officers and employees in the workplace together with a number of practical guidelines (the "Guidelines") for public officers and employees to follow during local special and general elections.

The laws governing the activities of public officers and employees during elections are intended to strike a balance between the rights of city employees to participate in political activity in their private capacity and the need for neutrality with regard to politics in the conduct of public business. On the one hand, public employees have political and free speech rights that they are entitled to exercise in their individual capacities.¹ On the other hand, the taxpayers who fund local governmental entities are entitled to a fair and unbiased election process free of the undue influence possible when public officers or employees use their official positions to promote specific political goals.²

Government Code Sections 3201 et seq. establish the statutory framework for cities with regard to employee political activities. Those provisions of law are set forth in full as following the text of this article. Essentially, the statutes prohibit regulation of political activities of public officers or employees by local agencies with limited exceptions. The statutory scheme specifically preempts local control of such matters except as permitted by statute. Section 3203 sets up the basic premise of the policy as follows:

"3203. Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, or as necessary to meet requirements of federal law as it pertains to a particular employee or employees, no restriction shall be placed on the political activities of any officer or employee of a state or local agency."

Section 3207 gives specific authority to local agencies to regulate some political activities of employees as follows:

"3207. Any city, county, or city and county charter, or, in the absence of a charter provision, the governing body of any local agency and any agency not subject to Section 19251 by establishing rules and regulations, may prohibit or otherwise restrict the following:

- (a) Officers and employees engaging in political activity during working hours.
- (b) Political activities on the premises of the local agency."

In addition, employees are prohibited from soliciting political contributions from other employees other than through blanket solicitations directed to the public at large. Section 3205 outlines this prohibition as follows:

"3205. (a) An officer or employee of a local agency shall not, directly or indirectly, solicit a political contribution from an officer or employee of that agency, or from a person on an employment list of that agency, with knowledge that the person from whom the contribution is solicited is an officer or employee of that agency.

(b) A candidate for elective office of a local agency shall not, directly or indirectly, solicit a political contribution from an officer or employee of that agency, or from a person on an employment list of that agency, with knowledge that the person from whom the contribution is solicited is an officer or employee of that agency.

(c) This section shall not prohibit an officer or employee of a local agency, or a candidate for elective office in a local agency, from requesting political contributions from officers or employees of that agency if the solicitation is part of a solicitation made to a significant segment of the public which may include officers or employees of that local agency.

(d) Violation of this section is punishable as a misdemeanor. The district attorney shall have all authority to prosecute under this section.

(e) For purposes of this section, the term "contribution" shall have the same meaning as defined in Section 82015."

Section 3206 prohibits political activities by city employees while in uniform as follows:

"3206. No officer or employee of a local agency shall participate in political activities of any kind while in uniform."

This comprehensive statutory scheme imposes a duty on public officers and employees to separate their personal political activities from activities that are sponsored by the public agency they serve and permits local agencies to prohibit all political activities by officers and employees on public property during working hours. The Guidelines below encompass suggested regulations that are consistent with the statutory framework and that may assist public agencies in implementing the prohibitions authorized by statute.

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SPECIAL GUIDELINES FOR LOCAL ELECTIONS

The following Guidelines have been developed based on California statutory law and the case law generated by the California courts.³ However, the Guidelines presented in this memorandum are general in application and are not intended to universally address the specific facts of each individual act or occurrence.

WHAT PUBLIC OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES MAY DO

1. Off Duty Activities.

Acting in his or her off-duty individual capacity, a public officer or employee may engage in any political activities (like campaigning and fundraisers).⁴

- a. Hourly Employees. For purposes of this Guideline, public officers and employees are considered to be "off-duty" before the commencement of, or at the end of, any standard or overtime hours in their shift or that they are otherwise required to work. Public officers and employees are considered to be "off-duty" for purposes of this Guideline when they are on their approved lunch break or when they are on vacation, have taken an administrative day, or during a public holiday.
- b. Salaried Employees. Public officers and employees who are salaried employees and do not have a regular shift or hours are considered to be "off-duty" before the commencement of, and after the end of, the public agency's normal business hours. A public officer or employee is considered to be "off-duty" for purposes of this guideline when they are on approved lunch breaks or when they are on vacation, have taken an administrative day, or during a public holiday.
- c. Political Activities. Political activities include such things as attending a political rally, participating in a campaign committee, sitting on a phone bank, doing campaign-related work, posting campaign signs, registering voters, or advocating that persons contribute or vote for or against a candidate or ballot measure.

2. Voting.

Acting in their personal capacities, public officers or employees may exercise their right to vote for or against any particular ballot measure or candidate. In voting for or against

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ballot measures or candidates, public officers and employees may be guided by their own judgment and conscience.⁵

A public officer or employee may vote for any candidate of his or her choice, even if voting against a current incumbent. They may also vote against a ballot measure even if it is officially supported by the public agency.

3. **Contributions.**

Acting in their personal capacities and guided by their good judgment and conscience public officers and employees may contribute to political campaigns, whether in support of, or opposition to, ballot measures or candidates.

Please note that the Political Reform Act regulates campaign contributions and disclosures. These rules may impact a personal decision to make a contribution.

4. **Soliciting Contributions from Public Agency Vendors.**

Public Officers and employees may request a list of public agency vendors and may contact those vendors and solicit campaign contributions for individual candidates and ballot measures.⁶

Public officers and employees, acting in their individual capacities, are permitted to solicit campaign contributions from public agency vendors for or against local ballot measures. They may also obtain a list of public agency vendors from the public agency for such purpose. However, as is discussed in more detail below, public officers and employees may not perform any of these activities while on duty or using public agency resources.

5. **Endorsements.**

Public officers and employees, including elected officials, may give whatever endorsements they choose on a personal level and they may include their public official title in such endorsements. Thus, a member of the legislative body may endorse particular candidates for other positions on the legislative body and may indicate in that endorsement that he is a member of that body himself. He may not, however, make any statement suggesting that he represents the legislative body in that endorsement.

WHAT AGENCY PUBLIC OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES MAY NOT DO

1. Political Activities During Work Hours.

Public officers and employees may not engage in political activities during work hours.⁷

For purposes of this rule, "during work hours" includes any standard or overtime hours that are part of a shift that a public officer or employee is required to work. However, a public officer or employee is considered "off-duty" for purposes of this guideline when he or she is on a permitted lunch break, vacation, administrative leave day, or during a public holiday.

Implementing this rule:

- a. **Distribute Materials.** A public officer or employee may not distribute political pamphlets, flyers, or other materials, or post political signs while on duty.
- b. **Campaign Events.** A public officer or employee may not attend campaign meetings, rallies or other campaign-related functions while on duty.
- c. **Telephone Calls.** A public officer or employee may not make campaign telephone calls while on duty.
- d. **Campaign Activities.** Public officers or employees may not perform any other campaign-related tasks while on duty. This would include making copies, stuffing envelopes, writing campaign statements or advocating or informing fellow workers about campaign issues. Wearing of campaign buttons or signs is also prohibited.

2. Political Activities on Public Property.

A public officer or employee may not engage in political activities on public property whether or not they are "off duty."⁸

For purposes of this Guideline, public property includes all property owned by a public agency, such as maintenance yards, community centers, and recreational facilities. However, this does not include use of a public park for which the sponsors of an event have obtained the appropriate permits or at public facilities (e.g., convention center, library, or other meeting hall) that are routinely available for private functions.

Implementing this rule:

- a. **Distribute Materials.** A public officer or employee may not distribute political pamphlets, flyers, or other materials, or post political signs on property owned by the public agency.

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- b. **Telephones/E-mail.** A public officer or employee may not use telephones of a public agency to make campaign telephone calls. This includes use of e-mail service provided to the public officer or employee by the public agency.
- c. **Campaign Events.** A public officer or employee may not participate in a political rally or other political function on agency property even when off duty. For example, if a campaign committee the public officer or employee is involved with plans a demonstration or rally on property near the public agency's location or during a meeting of the legislative body, the public officer or employee may not attend the rally even though he or she is off duty.
- d. **Campaign Activities.** A public officer or employee may not perform any other campaign-related tasks while on agency property. This would include making copies, stuffing envelopes, writing campaign statements or advocating or informing fellow workers about campaign issues. To do so would be to improperly use public resources.
- e. **Political Discussions.** While on agency property, a public officer or employee may not advocate, debate, or otherwise discuss with any person candidates or measures that are on the current ballot.

3. **Use Public Funds or Resources to Advocate.**

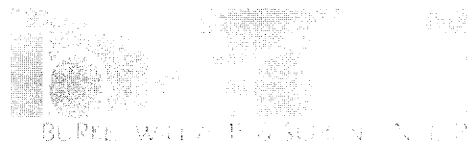
*A public officer or employee may **not** use public agency funds or resources to advocate a partisan position or otherwise use public agency funds or resources to support his or her personal political activities.⁹*

Implementing this rule:

- a. **Office Equipment.** A public officer or employee may not use agency copy machines, faxes, computers, printers or other office equipment to design, make, or distribute political pamphlets, flyers, signs, or other materials in support of his or her own political activity. To do so would be a misuse of public resources.
- b. **Telephones/E-mail.** A public officer or employee may not use agency phones in support of his or her personal political activities. Prohibited activities include: making political cold calls, calling any campaign organizations with which they may be involved, or otherwise using the phone to communicate personal views about candidates or ballot measures. This would include use of agency-provided e-mail addresses to send and receive messages relating to personal political activities.
- c. **Office Space.** A public officer or employee may not use a public office or workspace to engage in his or her personal political activities. Prohibited activities include: holding political meetings, organizing political events, preparing arguments, ballot statements,

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advertisements, and other such political activities. However, reviewing an official sample ballot for one's own information during an allowed break or lunch is permissible.

- d. **Office Equipment.** A public officer or employee may not use or take away agency office supplies in support of personal political activities. For example, a public officer or employee may not print off flyers on agency printer paper, take pens and paper clips for use at a campaign office, or use agency copiers to make oversized copies.

4. **Appearance in Uniform.**

Employees who wear an agency-provided or required uniform required by their employment may not participate in any political activity while in uniform.¹⁰

This Guideline is self-explanatory. If a public officer or employee wears a uniform that has become associated with a specific position at the agency, he or she may not appear at any political function in that uniform even when off duty. Examples of uniformed employees would include, fire, police, code enforcement, animal control, and public works crews.

5. **Solicitation of Campaign Contributions.**

A public officer or employee may not knowingly, directly or indirectly, solicit a contribution or donation for a political campaign from any agency officer or employee.¹¹

Implementing this rule:

- a. **Address List.** A public officer or employee may not obtain any list of officer's and employee's names and addresses to be used for personal political purposes. This would include requesting the list, or preparing the list for another person, using the list to solicit contributions, or using the list to send out mailers.
- b. **Direct Solicitation.** A public officer or employee may not ask (whether in person, by writing, or by e-mail) a fellow officer or employee to contribute or donate any money or time to a political cause or campaign.
- c. **Mass Mailings.** A public officer or employee may not intentionally include officers and employees known to them on a list that will be used in the distribution of political mailings. They may, however, participate in a mass mailing to all registered voters in the jurisdiction of the agency or within specific regions within the agency that may include Public officers and employees. The key is to not intentionally single out employees and officers.

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- d. **Phone Banks.** Although a public officer or employee may participate in a political phone bank, he or she may not knowingly call or instruct someone else to call fellow officers or employees.

6. **Use Position to Influence.**

A public officer or employee may not use the authority or influence of his or her official position to persuade or induce any officer or employee to take or refrain from taking any type of political action.¹²

Implementing this rule:

- a. **Vote.** A public officer or employee may not urge, encourage, or threaten a fellow officer or employee to vote or refrain from voting for a candidate or ballot measure.
- b. **Contribute.** A public officer or employee may not urge, encourage, or threaten a fellow officer or employee to contribute to a candidate or ballot measure.
- c. **Campaign.** A public officer or employee may not urge, encourage, or threaten a fellow officer or employee to campaign, or participate in a campaign, for or against, a candidate or ballot measure.

7. **Make Promises.**

A public officer or employee may not promise to provide any person with a gift, money, promotion, job, or other form of compensation in return for a contribution or vote.¹³

Implementing this rule:

- a. **Hiring.** A public officer or employee may not promise to hire or appoint any person for an agency position in return for a contribution or vote for or against any candidate or ballot measure.
- b. **Salaries.** A public officer or employee may not promise to increase the pay rate, salary, or fringe benefits of any officer or employee in return for a contribution or vote for or against any candidate or ballot measure.
- c. **Gifts.** A public officer or employee may not promise to provide any person with money, loan, or any type of gift in return for a contribution or vote for or against any candidate or ballot measure.

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- d. **Parties.** Based on the prohibition against gifts and money, a public officer or employee should not promise to hold a party, dinner, or other celebration which has been offered in exchange for a person's contribution or vote for or against any candidate or ballot measure. Please note that this is different than sponsoring a celebration party in the event that a candidate wins or a ballot measure is approved, or holding a fundraiser. These events are normally not conditioned upon a person casting a certain vote.

8. **Make Threats.**

*A public officer or employee may **not** threaten to take any action against any person in order to secure a contribution or influence a vote.¹⁴*

Implementing this rule:

- a. **Firing.** A public officer or employee may not threaten to fire, demote, or discipline any officer or employee in order to secure a contribution or vote.
- b. **Salaries.** A public officer or employee may not threaten to decrease the pay rate, salaries, or fringe benefits of any officer or employee to secure a contribution or vote.
- c. **Other Action.** A public officer or employee may not threaten to take any other action (e.g., violence or harassment) or to retaliate against any officer or employee in order to secure a contribution or vote.

9. **Pay Envelopes.**

*A public officer or employee may **not** enclose any political argument or statement in any public officer or employee's pay envelope.¹⁵*

Do not cause a political statement of any type or nature to be placed in a public officer or employee's pay envelope. This would include placement of any political stamps, slogans, or messages on the envelope itself.

10. **Obstructing or Corrupting the Election Process.**

*A public officer or employee may **not** take actions that obstruct and corrupt the election process.¹⁶*

Implementing this rule:

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- a. A public officer or employee may not interfere with any voter lawfully exercising the right to vote.
 - (1) May not physically bar any voter from entering a polling place.
 - (2) May not intentionally, directly or indirectly, delay or hinder any voter from reaching or entering a polling place.
 - (3) May not intimidate or threaten any voter in order to bar or hinder them in voting.
- b. A public officer or employee may not pay for any person's boarding or accommodations to secure a vote.
- c. A public officer or employee must stay at least 100 feet away from any polling place while soliciting votes, distributing materials, posting signs, or engaging in any other advocacy activity.
- d. A public officer or employee may not interfere with any of the Election Official's duties, including publishing sample ballots, canvassing the votes, or certifying or reporting the results of the election.
- e. A public officer or employee may not engage in any fraudulent election activity.
 - (1) May not make any false or misleading statement or argument in an attempt to induce any person to make a contribution or cast a particular vote or to refrain from voting.
 - (2) May not aid or participate in the illegal casting or counting of votes.

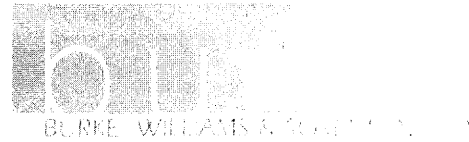
CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE SECTIONS 3201-3209

3201. The Legislature finds that political activities of public employees are of significant statewide concern. The provisions of this chapter shall supersede all provisions on this subject in the general law of this state or any city, county, or city and county charter except as provided in Section 3207.

3202. This chapter applies to all officers and employees of a state or local agency.

(a) "Local agency" means a county, city, city and county, political subdivision, district other than a school district, or municipal corporation. Officers and employees of a given local agency include officers and employees of any other local agency whose principal duties consist of providing services to the given local agency.

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(b) "State agency" means every state office, department, division, bureau, board, commission, superior court, court of appeal, the Supreme Court, the California State University, the University of California, and the Legislature.

3203. Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, or as necessary to meet requirements of federal law as it pertains to a particular employee or employees, no restriction shall be placed on the political activities of any officer or employee of a state or local agency.

3204. No one who holds, or who is seeking election or appointment to, any office or employment in a state or local agency shall, directly or indirectly, use, promise, threaten or attempt to use, any office, authority, or influence, whether then possessed or merely anticipated, to confer upon or secure for any individual person, or to aid or obstruct any individual person in securing, or to prevent any individual person from securing, any position, nomination, confirmation, promotion, or change in compensation or position, within the state or local agency, upon consideration or condition that the vote or political influence or action of such person or another shall be given or used in behalf of, or withheld from, any candidate, officer, or party, or upon any other corrupt condition or consideration. This prohibition shall apply to urging or discouraging the individual employee's action.

3205. (a) An officer or employee of a local agency shall not, directly or indirectly, solicit a political contribution from an officer or employee of that agency, or from a person on an employment list of that agency, with knowledge that the person from whom the contribution is solicited is an officer or employee of that agency.

(b) A candidate for elective office of a local agency shall not, directly or indirectly, solicit a political contribution from an officer or employee of that agency, or from a person on an employment list of that agency, with knowledge that the person from whom the contribution is solicited is an officer or employee of that agency.

(c) This section shall not prohibit an officer or employee of a local agency, or a candidate for elective office in a local agency, from requesting political contributions from officers or employees of that agency if the solicitation is part of a solicitation made to a significant segment of the public which may include officers or employees of that local agency.

(d) Violation of this section is punishable as a misdemeanor. The district attorney shall have all authority to prosecute under this section.

(e) For purposes of this section, the term "contribution" shall have the same meaning as defined in Section 82015.

3205.5. No one who holds, or who is seeking election or appointment to, any office shall, directly or indirectly, offer or arrange for any increase in compensation or salary for an employee of a state or local agency in exchange for, or a promise of, a contribution or loan to any committee controlled directly or indirectly by the person who holds, or who is seeking election or appointment to, an office. A violation of this section is punishable by imprisonment in a county jail for a period not exceeding one year, a fine not exceeding five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or by both that imprisonment and fine.

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3206. No officer or employee of a local agency shall participate in political activities of any kind while in uniform.

3207. Any city, county, or city and county charter or, in the absence of a charter provision, the governing body of any local agency and any agency not subject to Section 19251 by establishing rules and regulations, may prohibit or otherwise restrict the following:

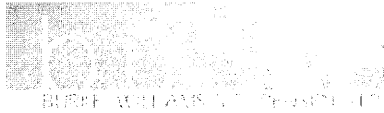
(a) Officers and employees engaging in political activity during working hours.

(b) Political activities on the premises of the local agency.

3208. Except as provided in Section 19990, the limitations set forth in this chapter shall be the only restrictions on the political activities of state employees.

3209. Nothing in this chapter prevents an officer or employee of a state or local agency from soliciting or receiving political funds or contributions to promote the passage or defeat of a ballot measure which would affect the rate of pay, hours of work, retirement, civil service, or other working conditions of officers or employees of such state or local agency, except that a state or local agency may prohibit or limit such activities by its employees during their working hours and may prohibit or limit entry into governmental offices for such purposes during working hours.

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PUBLIC LAW

Proposition 209, which prohibits public entities from awarding public contracts to discriminate or grant preferential treatment based on race or gender, does not violate the "political structure doctrine," a judicial interpretation of the federal equal protection clause that prohibits a state from imposing a political structure that invidiously discriminates. City's affirmative action programs for contractors did not fall within Proposition 209's federal-funding exemption where applicable federal laws merely permitted and did not require race- and gender-based preferential treatment. To prevail on its claim its affirmative action ordinance was necessary to redress its own past violations of the Equal Protection Clause, and thus took precedence over Proposition 209 as a matter of supreme federal law, city was required to prove that it had purposefully or intentionally discriminated based on race or gender; that the purpose of the ordinance was to provide a remedy for such discrimination; that the ordinance was narrowly tailored to achieve that purpose; and that a race- and gender-conscious remedy was necessary as the only, or at least the most likely, means of rectifying the resulting injury, and where trial court did not apply that standard in ruling on motion for summary judgment, it was appropriate to do so on remand.

ENVIRONMENTAL LAW

Where federal agencies' actions in extending leases of federal lands to energy producer were held by Court of Appeals to violate National Environmental Policy Act because agencies failed to produce an EIS regarding impact of the extensions on rights of local Indian tribe, district court did not abuse its equitable powers on remand by ordering that the original leases be treated as capable of extension, placing the parties as closely as possible to where they would and should have been when the extensions were improperly granted.

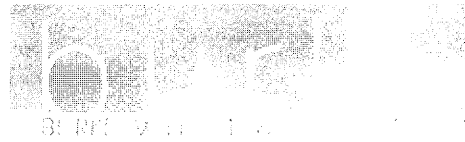

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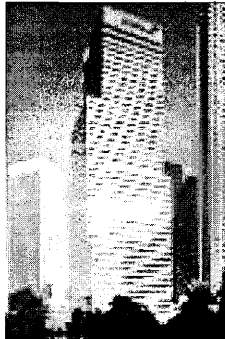
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LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT LAW

City did not violate plaintiff's rights under the ADA by requiring a fitness for duty exam after he repeatedly exhibited emotionally volatile behavior while serving as a police officer because it had an objective, legitimate basis to doubt his ability to perform the duties of a police officer. District court did not err in dismissing defendant's First Amendment retaliation claim because his complaints regarding a coworker with whom he shared duties did not address matters of public concern. City did not violate Family Medical Leave Act by making plaintiff submit to a fitness for duty exam after he was examined by his primary care physician where no reasonable juror could misread the letter as stating that plaintiff had recovered from the psychological issues that rendered him unfit for duty.

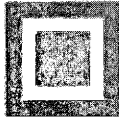

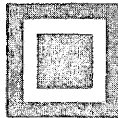

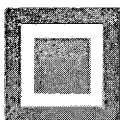

Dear Mr. Briggs:

This correspondence follows the Grossmont Union High School District's ("District") prior response to your October 26, 2016 requests for information and/or records under the California Public Records Act ("CPRA") (Gov't Code § 6250, *et seq.*). Please be advised that this letter constitutes the District's final response to your request for records.

Under the PRA, a public agency must provide non-privileged or non-exempt public records in response to a request that reasonably identifies a public record or records. The PRA does not require public agencies to answer questions or interrogatories, create documents, compile lists, or summarize records in response to a public records request. (*See* Govt. Code § 6253(b).).

In the introductory letter to the PRA request you alleged that Superintendent Tim Glover engaged in "illegal, potentially criminal, political activity as a public employee in relation to the Measure BB on the November 2016 Ballot." The District takes all allegations of violation of laws, rules and regulations seriously. In this situation, the allegations are completely false and extremely disheartening for Dr. Glover. District staff, including Dr. Glover, who in their private capacity worked on the bond campaign, were directly educated about the rules and regulations. As previously stated in my November 9, 2016 letter, Dr. Glover and other District staff were careful to adhere to the strict rules and regulations related to the bond campaign.

However, there were a few times that Dr. Glover and/or other District staff inadvertently sent bond campaign messages over the District server instead of only using personal emails. Such emails include those Dr. Glover inadvertently sent from his personal email account ("theglov8@gmail.com") to District email accounts and those other District employees

inadvertently sent from their District accounts to Dr. Glover's personal account. Again, there was no direct effort to send emails using the District system, rather the only intent was to abide by the rules and regulations. The mistake of using the wrong email address was a very rare occurrence.

Throughout the bond campaign, Dr. Glover and the other staff members working on the "Yes on BB" campaign remained extremely observant and mindful about ensuring the rules and regulations were followed. As you will see through the responsive documents, Dr. Glover provided factual information only as is allowed by the law, to the PTA. Additionally, prior to the Principal's Council Meeting on September 14, 2016, some of those who attend the meeting often gather for lunch together during this duty-free time. So during this off-duty lunch period, the "Yes on BB" campaign held a meeting for those who would be attending the Principal's Council meeting and were voluntarily involved with the campaign. For the convenience of the attendees, the meeting was held at the District Office. However, the meal was provided by an outside entity, the East County Schools Federal Credit Union, and none of the materials brought to the meeting were printed on campus or using District resources and/or funds.

In summary, your allegations are false. Dr. Glover did not pressure anyone to campaign or work at a phone bank, did not require subordinate employees to use their "official public-employee credentials" while working at the phone banks, and did not direct any subordinate employees to fill phone-banking shifts during working hours. Further, Dr. Glover did not spend public funds on the "Yes on BB" campaign. Rather, the "Yes on BB" campaign created a volunteer opportunity for District staff and others to support the bond and the "Yes on BB" campaign, who provided all the foods and snacks for the volunteers.

The District has revised its response and now responds to your public records requests as follows:

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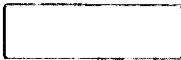

Taken together these 3 bond measures add about \$300-\$400/year in taxes for the average Alpine and Blossom Valley homeowner. Keep in mind you probably have already paid thousands of dollars to Grossmont since the passage of H in 2004 and U in 2008. When interest is added, Alpiners alone will have to pay back \$125 million to bond holders and you will

continue to pay this steep bill for decades to come.

Grossmont has "authority" to issue another \$100+ million in Prop U bonds so why are they asking for this new bond? Grossmont has burned through bond funds so quickly it reached the maximum amount it can tax property owners under that bond. In other words, it has maxed out its credit card against you, the taxpayer, and can't borrow any more money in the bond market for several years. Grossmont now has the audacity to come back to ask taxpayers for a "bridge loan", Measure BB, so they can get their hands on your hard earned money to cover their lavish spending plans until the Prop U spigot re-opens.

What has Alpine and Blossom Valley gotten from these huge bond measures? Not a thing – not even a stick in the ground. There is no Alpine high school under construction and despite specific references in both H and U (and now in BB) to construct the high school there are no plans, now or in the future, to do so. In fact, all work on the school has ceased and the design plans for the school were withdrawn in 2012. The school is at the bottom of Grossmont's project list and all bond funds will be long gone before a spade of dirt is lifted to build the school.

However, Grossmont did spend \$25 Million of your tax dollars to acquire the Lazy A site (90 acre parcel adjacent to the Albertson's center), develop detailed architectural plans, and acquire state and federal environmental permits to build the school on the site. Unless construction commences soon (which it won't) these critical permits will expire, rendering the Lazy A completely worthless as a school site and flushing your \$25 Million down the drain.

So what has Grossmont done with the huge sum of money collected under H and U? In addition to the Alpine/Blossom Valley school, they told voters bond funds would be used to "repair, renovate, rehabilitate, and upgrade facilities", just like they are now stating in BB. Instead much of that money went to build new Olympic size swimming pools and aquatic centers, performing arts theaters, day care facilities, administrative offices, and other pork barrel projects while badly needed renovations in many schools went undone. They also spent bond funds on management fees, administrative overhead, and legal fees. In other words, instead of building what they told voters, the bond funds have been spent on whatever favorite projects were lobbied for by those political constituents most favored by the Grossmont governing board.

Grossmont claims there will be "strict fiscal accountability" for how they handle BB bond funds with oversight from the "independent" Citizens Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC). This is another phony promise. The current CBOC (for H and U) made a mockery of the word "independent" and essentially operated as a political arm of the Grossmont governing board. The questionable handling of bond funds and poor CBOC oversight has been the subject of sharp criticism by the press, the San Diego County Taxpayers Association, and other respected individuals and entities. Such conduct along with misleading statements to bond investors led to a Forbes magazine article that said the following about Grossmont:

"{Grossmont} was alleged to have diverted monies from a voter-approved measure and into non-authorized projects – a classic bait and switch scheme. When we investors read that what the uses of money are for and the issuer does not adhere to that specified project, why aren't the people involved in jail? ... Once {Grossmont} had the money in their hot little hands they thought they could do whatever they wanted with it rather than what they promised the taxpayers..."

Grossmont's failure to build the Alpine high school also caught the attention of the San Diego County Grand Jury. In 2012 the Grand Jury issued a scathing report entitled "Fool Us Once, Fool Us Twice" in which Grossmont was taken to task for not building the school as required in Props H and U. It made specific findings and recommendations to build the school which Grossmont completely ignored. The Grand Jury, therefore, would not be the least surprised that Grossmont now wants to fool us a third time with Measure BB.





