Valley of the Moon - Which may include: Smuggler's Cave, an old hideout of bandits and smugglers off I-8 East just past the San Diego/Imperial County line in a high desert area near the Mexican border. Possible side trips to Elliot Mine and Blue Angels Peak Monument. This hike is rated HARD with the out and back distance at 7 to 8.6 miles (approx. 4 hrs. round trip). No dogs please. Andrade Slot Canyon - This hike is 4 to 6 miles and takes you to Coyote Mountains via highway S-2 in the Anza Borrego State Park. From the trailhead we will proceed into the Coyote Mtns. to Andrade Canyon where we will climb down a brief but exciting drop that begins one of the most interesting hikes in these mountains. Myer Creek to "Happys" Upper Camp - This 4 to 5 mile EXTREME hike begins at Mountain Springs Grade and takes us into the Jacumba Wilderness via Myer Creek. We will walk amid giant boulders, dry creek beds with occasional springs. We will encounter morteros and high desert flora including several palm oases on our way to the legendary recluse "Happys" deserted lower home site. We then climb out of the creek bed to the spectacular views of Upper Myer Valley and then on to "Happy's" remote upper camp. This hike is strenuous and includes bouldering.
