San Diego State Postgame Notes vs. San Diego

Notes

- * San Diego State wins its fourth straight season opener and its seventh consecutive season opener at Viejas Arena.
- * In its seven straight season-opening wins at Viejas Arena, all have come by double figures.
- * The Aztecs won their fifth consecutive game in the outing immediately following a loss. SDSU ended 2015-16 with a NIT semifinal loss to George Washington.
- * SDSU improves to 12-1 in its last 13 home games and is now 160-20 at home since the start of the 2005-06 campaign.
- * San Diego State improves to 57-4 in its last 61 games vs. schools from California. The Aztecs also improve to 47-1 in their last 48 against non-conference California universities.
- * Had two players score at least 20 points in a game for the first times since Jan. 15, 2012, vs. UNLV when Jamaal Franklin went for 24 and James Rahon had 22.

Series Notes

- * SDSU improves to 30-18 all-time vs. the Toreros and 21-8 vs. USD at home.
- * The Aztecs have won 10 straight games vs. San Diego in games played indoors.
- * San Diego State has won 10 of the last 11 meetings with the Toreros.
- * Steve Fisher improves to 13-5 vs. USD.

Player Notes

Jeremy Hemsley – 25 pts, 4 rebounds, 2 assists, 3 steals

Posted a career-high 25 points (previous best was 23)... Notched his fifth career 20-point performance, two of which occurred in the first game of the last two seasons (20 vs. Illinois State last season)... Recorded his 27th career double-figure scoring game...Matched career-high with 4 three-pointers... Set a career high with 9 field goals (previous best was 8 vs. Illinois State).

Trey Kell – 23 pts, 4 rebounds, 2 assists, 1 steal

Scored a season high 23 points... Posted his third career 20-point performance and his 35th career double-digit scoring game.

D'Erryl Williams – 3 pts, 5 rebounds, 2 steals, 1 assist

Played a career-high 29 minutes, surpassing his previous best of 18 at Fresno State (1-3-15)... Made his fourth career three-pointer after entering the season 3-for-7 for his career... Tied career-high with two steals.

Montague Gill-Caesar — 2 pts, 4 rebounds

Started in his SDSU debut, becoming the first Aztec transfer since Josh Davis (2013-14) to start the first game of the season.
