

# San Diego State Postgame Notes – vs. Georgia

Final Score: San Diego State 75, Georgia 68 Next Game: Sunday, Nov. 26, vs. Washington State (Wooden Legacy championship game), 9 p.m. PT | ESPN2

## Team Notes

- San Diego State closed out a 61-all game with 5:00 to play to defeat Georgia, 75-68, to improve to 5-1.
- The Aztecs are 5-1 for the first time since 2014-15.
- SDSU picked up its first win over a current SEC school since Dec. 21, 1985, when it beat Florida in Las Vegas.
- The win is the Aztecs third vs. a current SEC school. They also defeated Missouri in San Diego on Dec. 21, 1978.
- San Diego State improved to 5-0 all-time at the Wooden Legacy and will make its second straight appearance in the title game (2013).
- The Aztecs will make their sixth straight title-game appearance in an eight-team in-season tournament since 2008-09.
- SDSU picked up its first win of the season when trailing at halftime. The Aztecs faced a 34-33 deficit at intermission.
- The Aztecs overcame a 12-point deficit to win. It was the largest deficit overcome by the Aztecs this season.
- San Diego State committed a season-low five turnovers, a game after it had 20.

## **Player Notes**

#### Devin Watson – 16 points, 4 rebounds, 4 assists

Posted his fourth double-figure scoring game of the season and fourth in a row... It marked his 46<sup>th</sup> career double-digit scoring effort... Led the team in assists for the third time.

### Trey Kell – 13 points, 9 rebounds, 5 assists, 1 steal

Recorded his fifth straight double-figure scoring effort (5<sup>th</sup> of the season) and the 63<sup>rd</sup> of his career... Led the team with nine rebounds, which was one shy of his season high... Led the team in rebounding for a second time this season... Had a game-high five assists, marking the second time he has led in the category, and zero turnovers... Has 14 assists in his last three games.

#### Matt Mitchell - 13 points, 2 rebounds

Recorded his third straight double-figure scoring game and the third of his career... Made his only three-pointer with 2:44 left in the game to put SDSU up by four points... He is 10-for-22 from three-point distance in his last three games after starting his career by going 0-for-10 from deep.

#### Jalen McDaniels – 11 points, 8 rebounds, 1 steal

Scored a career-high 11 points... Grabbed eight rebounds after snatching 13 vs. Sacramento State... Made a career-high seven free throws (7-8) after going 4-for-4 on Thursday... Started his season by missing his first four attempts from the line, covering five games.
