

San Diego State Postgame Notes – vs. Sacramento State

Team Notes

- San Diego State moved to 4-1 for the second straight season and has won three straight games.
- The Aztecs are 14-2 in eight-team in-season tournaments since 2008-09.
- SDSU is 4-0 all-time at the Wooden Legacy after going 3-0 and winning the tournament in 2013.
- San Diego State improved to 4-1 all-time vs. Sacramento State and has won four in a row vs. the Hornets.
- SDSU has won 22 consecutive non-conference games vs. Cal State University schools.
- The Aztecs scored 89 points, marking its third straight game with at least 83 points.

Game Notes

- San Diego State's largest lead was 47 points with 15:12 left in the second half.
- SDSU scored the game's first 12 points.
- San Diego State led, 49-14, at halftime and made 12 of its 14 free-throw attempts in the first half (.857).
- The Aztecs forced Sacramento State to miss its first 14 three-pointers.
- All 10 Aztecs who saw action in the first half scored at least three points... All 11 Aztecs overall scored in the game.
- SDSU outrebounded the Hornets, 50-26, to improve to 4-0 this season when outrebounding its foe.

Player Notes

Devin Watson – 12 points, 1 rebound, 2 assists, 3 steals

Posted his third double-figure scoring game of the season and third in a row... It marked his 45th career double-digit scoring effort... Reached the double-figure scoring plateau in the first half alone with 12 points... Tied his season high with three steals.

Trey Kell – 11 points, 2 assists

Recorded his fourth straight double-figure scoring effort (4th of the season) and the 62nd of his career... Has nine assists in his last two games... Made his only three-point attempt and has made at least one trey in every game this season.

Matt Mitchell – 11 points, 3 rebounds, 1 assist

Recorded his second straight double-figure scoring game and the second of his career... Has at least one assist in every game this year.

Kameron Rooks – 6 points, 9 rebounds, 1 blocked shot, 1 steal

Collected a season-high nine rebounds... Blocked at least one shot in three straight outings... Knocked both of his free-throw attempts, his first two tries of the season.

Jalen McDaniels – 8 points, 13 rebounds

Set a career high in rebounding... Logged his first career double-digit rebounding effort... His 13 rebounds are the most for an Aztec this season... Went 4-for-4 from the charity stripe after opening the season 0-for-4.

Jeremy Hemsley – 10 points, 3 rebounds, 3 assists, 1 steal

Logged his second double-figure scoring game of the season and his first since the season opener... Has multiple assists in every game this season.
