Game Notes

- San Diego State had its three-game win streak snapped today.
- San Diego State is 15-3 following a loss this season.
- Mark Martinez falls to 5-5 in his career against teams that played in the College World Series the year prior.

Team Notes

- San Diego State scored four runs despite having only six hits on the afternoon.
- SDSU allowed just one extra-base hit against LSU (nine total hits for the Tigers).
- The Aztecs held the Tigers without a hit the first 10 times that LSU batted with a runner in scoring position.
- SDSU had the leadoff man to start an inning just once against LSU.
- SDSU limited LSU to a .200 (2-for-10) batting average with two outs.
- SDSU's 4-7 hitters in the lineup were a collective 5-for-16 (.313) with three runs scored and an RBI.
- The Aztecs bullpen allowed only five hits over 5.0 innings pitched today.

Julian Eschedo

2-for-4, 2B, R, RBI, SB

- Reached base for the 23rd consecutive game (longest active streak on the team).
- Has a hit on a team-best five consecutive games.
- Posted his 19th multiple-hit game of the campaign.

Jacob Maekawa

1-for-3, 2 RBI

- One of three players to start all 59 games this season.
- Had his seventh multiple-RBI game of the campaign and matched his season-high for runs batted in.
- Extended his streak of reaching base safely to 12 games.
- Has now hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games.

Jordan Verdon

1-for-4, 2B, R

- Recorded his 27th double in the season and now is just four behind Chris Gwynn's school-record of 31 set in 1984.
- Recorded his 38th extra-base hit of the season, the most by an Aztec since Chris Gwvnn hit 59 in 1984.
- He entered the day ranked fourth nationally in doubles.

Dean Nevarez

1-for-4, R

Reached base for the 14th consecutive game.

Jacob Erickson

2.2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 2 K

- Pitched in his school and Mountain West Conference record 120th career game.
- Had a streak of 8.1 consecutive scoreless innings snapped after holding LSU scoreless for the first two innings of his outing.
- Leads all active NCAA DI players in career appearances.
- He has now stranded 19 of 31 inherited runners this season.
