San Diego State Postgame Notes – vs. [7] Nevada

Final Score: [7] Nevada 95, [10] San Diego State 84 - Overtime

Team Notes

- San Diego State had three players with at least five assists (McKynzie Fort – 6, Najé Murray – 5, Geena Gomez – 5), marking the second time in the last four games the Aztecs have accomplished the feat.
- The Aztecs had 20 assists on 33 baskets, marking the fifth time this season SDSU has had at least 20 assists in a game.
- SDSU's bench scored 37 points, its most since it had 44 vs. Hope International on Dec. 10, 2017.

Player Notes

McKynzie Fort – 25 points, 7 rebounds, 6 assists, 2 blocked shots

Reached double figures in scoring for the 25th time this season and for the 93rd time of her career... Her 25 points was her third-highest scoring output this season... Tied her career high with two blocked shots... Finished her career 1,708 points (3rd all-time at SDSU), 519 rebounds and 303 assists (10th all-time at SDSU)... She scored in all 121 games in her career... Her 121 games played is tied for the seventh most in school history.

Cheyenne Greenhouse – 16 points, 7 rebounds, 1 assist, 1 steal

Scored a season-high 16 points... Made her only attempt from three-point distance, which was her first trey of the season on her fifth attempt... Posted her 16th career double-figure scoring game... Shared team-high honors in rebounding (7) with McKynzie Fort... Played in 121 career games, which is tied for the seventh most in school history with Fort.

Naomi Ekwedike – 8 points, 2 rebounds, 1 assist, 1 blocked shot

Set a career high with eight points... Scored 12 points in her last two games, which tied a two-game season high.

Geena Gomez – 6 points, 5 rebounds, 5 assists

Posted her 10th game of the season with at least five assists... Finished her career with a three-point field-goal percentage of .361 (115-319), which is the third best in school history.

Khalia Lark – 6 points, 4 rebounds

Connected on at least one three-pointer for the fifth straight game, which is her longest streak of the season... Prior to the current stretch of consecutive games with a trey, she had never made a three-pointer in more than three straight games.
