Postgame Football Notes — San Diego State vs. UCLA

Team Notes

- The Aztecs fell to 20-5 in all games played in September since the start of the 2016 campaign.
- SDSU fell to 74-31 (.705) since the start of the 2015 campaign.
- San Diego State dropped to 7-3 all-time at Snapdragon Stadium.
- SDSU allowed a rush longer than 20 yards on the 11th attempt of the game, which was the 58th attempt of the season.
- SDSU fell to 2-1 this season and 32-4 under Brady Hoke when owning a better average field position.
- The Aztecs fell to 1-1 this season and 25-6 under Brady Hoke when having more time of possession.
- San Diego State forced two turnovers and have forced eight this season in three games (six interceptions, two fumbles).

Trends

- The Aztecs won the coin toss for the second time this season in three games.
- SDSU did not start with the ball for just the 41st time in the last 148 games.
- San Diego State did not allow its opponent to score on its opening possession for the second time this season (both three-and-outs), 22nd time since 2021 (30 games) and 76th time since 2015 (105 games).

<u>Player Notes</u>

* Jalen Mayden, Sr., QB (19-for-37, 196 yds., 1 TD, 3 INT | 9 att., 18 yds.)

Fell to 7-4 as SDSU's starting quarterback ... Threw his first touchdown pass of the season and 16th of his career.

* Mekhi Shaw, Jr., WR (5 rec., 54 yds., 1 TD | 2 PR, 15 yds.)

Scored his first touchdown of the season and fourth of his career ... Recorded season highs of five catches and 54 yards after entering the game with four receptions for 52 yards over his first two games.

* Mark Redman, Sr., TE (5 rec., 32 yds.)

Had his second game this season with five receptions ... Already has 12 catches for 102 yards (8.5 avg.) and two touchdowns this year in three games (last year he had 21 receptions for 233 yards (11.1 avg.) and two touchdowns in 13 games.

* Zyrus Fiaseu, So., LB (12 tackles (8 solo), 1.0 sack, 2.0 TFL, 2 FF, 1 FR, 1 PBU, 1 QBH)

Entered the game with six tackles this season, and finished with seven in the first half and a career-high 12 for the game (previous high was four) ... Also forced his first two fumbles and recovered his first career fumble ... The two forced fumbles tied a SDSU single-game record (14th occasion) ... Tied a season and career high with two tackles for loss, and now has four this season and 5.5 for his career ... Logged his second sack of the season and has 2.5 for his career ... Had his first career pass breakup.

* Jack Browning, Sr., K/P (1-for-1 FG, 44 LG | 1-for-1 PAT | 7 P, 43.0 avg., 50 LG, 2 I20 | 3 KO, 65.0 avg., 2 TB)

Made a 44-yard field goal ... Is now 5-for-6 on field goal attempts this season and 25-for-31 for his career ... His 25 field goals are tied for the 10th most in program history.

Other Notes

- CB Dez Malone started for the 14th straight game, the longest streak among offensive and defensive players.
- CB Noah Tumblin played in his 37th consecutive game, the longest streak on the team.
- S Cedarious Barfield played in his 41st career game, the most among any current Aztec.
- The following players made their first career start at SDSU: WR Phillippe Wesley, LB New Zealand Williams and S Deshawn McCuin (one start at TCU).
- LB Trey White recovered his first career fumble.
- Today's temperature was 85 degrees at kickoff.
- Today's attendance was 32,017.
- Today's Aztec Honor Warrior was Kassim Osgood (2002).
